**WIRELESS ACCESS POLICY**

Wireless Internet Access (Wi-Fi) is provided free of charge by the Edith B. Ford Memorial Library for patrons who have the required hardware and software needed for this service. Use of this service is governed by the Edith B. Ford Memorial Library's Internet Use Policy.

Use of the Edith B. Ford Memorial Library's Wi-Fi service is your agreement with the terms and conditions of this policy:

1. Wi-Fi access is provided as a free public service on an "as is" basis with no guarantee of service.
2. Users are responsible for setting up their equipment to access Edith B. Ford Memorial Library's Wi-Fi network. Library staff will not provide technical assistance and will not assume any responsibility for personal hardware configurations, security or changes to data files resulting from connection to the library's Wi-Fi network. It is recommended that users make a backup copy of any settings changed before configuring their equipment for use on the library's Wi-Fi network.
3. All Wi-Fi users should have up-to-date antivirus software installed on their computers.
4. As with most public Wi-Fi networks, the Edith B. Ford Memorial Library's wireless network is not secure. Any information transmitted (including credit card numbers, passwords, and other sensitive information) could potentially be intercepted by another computer user.
5. The Edith B. Ford Memorial Library is not responsible for any information that is compromised, or for any damage caused to your hardware or software due to electric surges, security issues or consequences caused by viruses or hacking. The library assumes no responsibility for damage to or loss of equipment; users must keep their equipment with them at all times.
6. The library's Wi-Fi network is subject to periodic maintenance and unforeseen downtime.
7. The Wi-Fi service is provided for non-commercial use only.
8. Printing access is not available via the Wi-Fi network. If the user desires to print, the file can be saved to a flash drive or sent to a personal email and printed for a nominal fee at a public computer.
