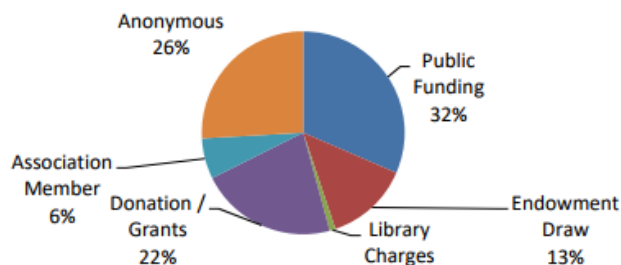

Total Expenses

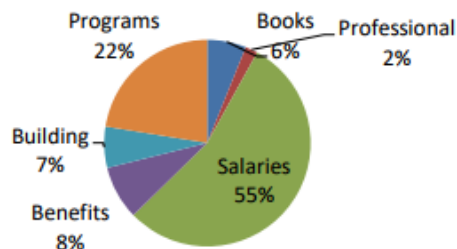
