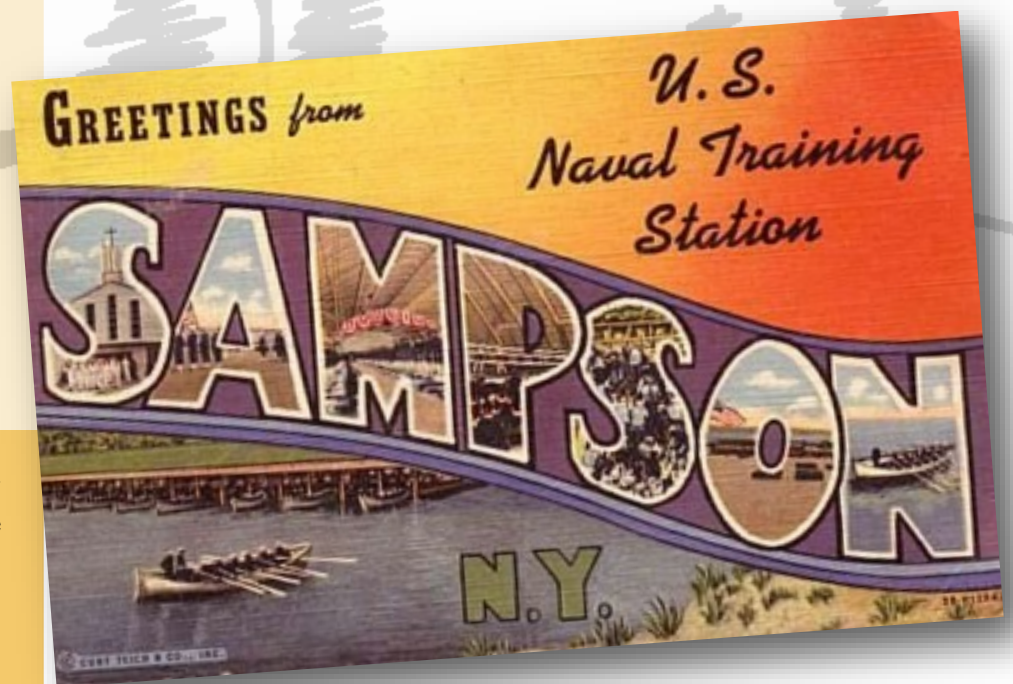


A WALK THROUGH LOCAL HISTORY WITH HISTORIAN WALTER GABLE

FEATURING: SAMPSON NAVAL BASE



When the word “Sampson” is used, it is easy to think of Sampson Air Force Base, or Sampson State Park.

Actually there is a great deal more to the “history” of that portion of Seneca County. Seneca County Historian Walter Gable will trace the history of the area that has become known as Sampson from the establishment of the Sampson Naval Station in 1942 up to the present. He will discuss how the area became Sampson College, a Civil Defense storage facility, a part of Willard State Hospital, a Youth Town facility, as well as its consideration for a nuclear atomic reactor or a nuclear fuel re-processing plant.
